1 APPLY

- Complete online application (drakestate.edu)
- Request transcripts from all previous schools including high school
- Complete residency certificate
- Submit a copy of your valid ID

2 FINANCIAL AID

- Complete FAFSA application (fafsa.ed.gov)
- Drake State school code is **005260**
- For 2019-2020 academic year, report 2017 income information/tax records. For 2020-2021 academic year, report 2018 income information/tax records

3 NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

- All new students are required to register for and attend an iStart Session
- You will receive information on registration via email and U.S. mail

4 REGISTER FOR CLASSES

- New students are required to meet with an Academic Completion Specialist before registering for the first semester

5 TESTING AND PLACEMENT

- Placement in College level math and English is according to the student's evaluated high school transcript, ACT Scores or ACCUPLACER placement test results.
