Persons sixty (60) years of age or older may be eligible for a tuition waiver if they qualify for the Senior Adult Scholarship Program in accordance with board policy 805.02. Applicants must meet the following conditions:

- Comply with the college admission standards as noted in the school's catalog under Admissions, First-time Student Admission, Transfer Student or Former Student apply for Readmissions.
- Must be an Alabama resident
- Must be U.S. citizen or provide documented evidence of U.S. citizenship, including naturalized citizenship, U.S. permanent residency status, U.S. resident alien status and U.S. alien status
- Must be sixty (60) years of age or older.
- Student must enroll for credit; noncredit enrollment is not eligible.
- Student must declare a major.
- Submit federal or state issued picture identification in the Office of Financial Aid.
- Student cannot exceed 180 credit hours
- Must be meeting Satisfactory Academic Progress standards as indicated in the current college catalog.
- Scholarship waiver is awarded for one (1) course per semester.

The scholarship/waiver is limited to TUITION ONLY and does not extend to any other fees or charges applied to the general student body. Required institutional fees and other expenses, including lab fees, books, and supplies are the responsibility of the student prior to the first day of class. Senior citizens granted a tuition waiver under the Senior Adult Scholarship Program may receive the tuition waiver only one time per course. Any time a senior citizen repeats a course the student is responsible for the tuition and fees of this repeated course. A course is considered a repeat if the student withdraws from the course or fails the course on a previous attempt. Scholarships are limited based on availability of space.

- **This is a one-time application and must be submitted to the Office of Financial Aid for processing prior to the first term it is to be in effect.**
- **Each term the student is to submit an upcoming semester schedule prior to the last day of regular registration for the waiver funding to be added to a student account.**
